- Explore how even small every day interactions can help provide safety and recovery to a student.


These top-up sessions will be delivered online and are suitable for all staff members.

Children's Mental Health Week

From the 9th -15th of Feb 2026 we commemorate Children's Mental Health Week. The theme for 2026 is "This is My Place," this highlights the importance of feeling belonging, finding your identity and having a support system. This awareness week was first introduced in 2015 by Place2be, who's aim is to ensure that no young person or child has to face mental health difficulties alone.

Research from BBC Children in Need and NHS Mental health service shows that: Over 1 million children (under 18) were in contact with NHS mental health services in 2024-25 and approximately 32% of children and young people, have expressed they do not feel comfortable asking for support.
